





Understanding iSTECAMMO (1/5)

Streams and Capability Areas

The Stewardship Capability Maturity Model (iSTECAMMO) is a framework designed to evaluate and nurture students' growth across three streams—Academic Development (Head), Character Development (Heart), and Business & Career Development (Hand)—through defined capability areas. These streams ensure holistic development by integrating intellectual, personal, and professional growth into the curriculum.

Streams and Capability Areas:

1. Academic Development (Head):

Focus: Intellectual capabilities such as critical thinking, analytical skills, adaptability, and intellectual curiosity.

Capability Areas:

- Critical Thinking: Ability to analyse and evaluate information systematically.
- Problem Solving: Tackling challenges with effective solutions.
- Adaptability: Learning new skills in changing environments.
- Research Skills: Gathering, interpreting, and presenting data.

2. Character Development (Heart):

Focus: Moral and ethical growth with an Islamic dimension, including personal values and self-control. Capability Areas:

- Empathy: Understanding and sharing others' feelings.
- Integrity: Upholding honesty and moral principles.
- Resilience: Enduring and overcoming challenges.
- Self-Control: Managing emotions and impulses effectively.

3. Business & Career Development (Hand):

•Focus: Practical skills for career readiness and entrepreneurship.

Capability Areas:

- Leadership: Inspiring and guiding others.
- **Teamwork**: Collaborating effectively with peers.
- Entrepreneurial Thinking: Innovating and taking initiative.
- Professionalism: Demonstrating ethical and responsible behaviour.



Understanding iSTECAMMO (2/5)

Capability Maturity Assessment Per Stream and Phase

Each capability is assessed using five maturity levels across the Play, Teach, and Advise phases:

1.Play Phase:

- Goal: Introduce foundational skills in each capability area.
- Assessment: Students are observed and evaluated on basic awareness and early application of skills. For instance:
 - 1. Academic Development: Ability to identify patterns or solve simple problems.
 - 2. Character Development: Demonstrating empathy and basic self-regulation in group activities.
 - 3. Business & Career Development: Participating in team-based games or role-playing scenarios.

2.Teach Phase:

- Goal: Build proficiency through guided practice and structured learning experiences.
- Assessment: Students are evaluated on consistent application of capabilities in familiar scenarios. For example:
 - 1. Academic Development: Applying research skills to small projects or group discussions.
 - 2. Character Development: Showing resilience in overcoming classroom challenges.
 - 3. Business & Career Development: Leading small group tasks or managing simple projects.

3. Advise Phase:

- Goal: Develop advanced mastery and independence in applying capabilities.
- Assessment: Students are assessed on their ability to demonstrate excellence in diverse, real-world scenarios. For instance:
 - 1. Academic Development: Conducting independent research and presenting findings.
 - 2. Character Development: Acting as a role model for integrity and self-control.
 - 3. Business & Career Development: Leading a group project or pitching a business idea.





Understanding iSTECAMMO (3/5)

Adding Up Within Each Stream

Per Capability: Each capability within a stream is scored based on the student's current maturity level (e.g., Level 1: Foundational, Level 5: Exemplary).

For example:

• If a student scores "3" in Critical Thinking, "4" in Problem Solving, and "2" in Adaptability within Academic Development, their overall score for that stream is averaged or weighted based on importance.

Stream Score: All capabilities within a stream contribute to an aggregate score that reflects the student's overall maturity in that stream. For instance:

Academic Development: (Critical Thinking + Problem Solving + Adaptability + Research Skills) ÷ Number of Capabilities.



Understanding iSTECAMMO (4/5) How Everything Adds Up Across Streams

- Integration Across Streams:
 - Each stream contributes to a holistic picture of the student's development. The overall maturity score combines the individual stream scores (Academic, Character, and Business & Career).
 - Weighting can vary based on program focus (e.g., Character Development might carry more weight in early phases, while Business & Career Development becomes more significant in later phases).
- Overall Stewardship Capability Score:
 - The final score reflects the student's maturity in **Stewardship Capability**, combining intellectual, ethical, and professional growth.
 - Example Calculation:
 - Academic Development: 3.5
 - Character Development: 4.0
 - Business & Career Development: 3.8
 - Overall Score: (3.5 + 4.0 + 3.8) ÷ 3 = 3.77 (rounded to two decimals)



Understanding iSTECAMMO (5/5)

Gap Analysis and Improvement Planning

Identifying Gaps:

- Gaps are highlighted for capabilities scoring below a certain threshold (e.g., Level 3: Proficient).
- For instance, a low score in "Self-Control" may point to challenges in resilience or teamwork.

Targeted Improvement:

- Improvement strategies are tailored to specific gaps, focusing on activities or lessons aligned with the deficient capability.
- Coaches work with students on Personal Development Plans (PDPs) to track progress.

Phase-Driven Growth:

Students transition from foundational skills in the Play Phase to advanced mastery in the Advise Phase, with the iSTECAMMO providing clear markers of progress.

By integrating these streams and capabilities into the iSTECAMMO framework, Stewards.ONE ensures a well-rounded, purpose-driven education that tracks, measures, and enables growth across intellectual, personal, and professional domains.
